

Please use only the well established tracks along dune corridors.

**Hay River Watercourse**  
During large floods the Hay River divides into a network of small streams. These watercourses are hidden in the dune corridors on either side of the track.

Due to the fragile nature of this area, please explore carefully on foot only.

Sand dunes on this shoreline are stable, but travel is slow.

The K1 Line follows dune corridors for most of its length.

Detour north of salt lakes when they are impassable due to flooding

# SIMPSON DESERT

**Simpson Desert**  
This is the largest parallel sand dune desert in the world. It is a beautiful place but can also be dangerous. Always exercise care and common sense.

**NOTE:** A Desert Parks Pass is required before entering Wiljira National Park or Simpson Desert Regional Reserve. Passes are available from the National Parks and Wildlife Service offices and agencies.

**WAA Line**  
Similar to the French Line, but generally has less traffic.

**Warburton Track - K1 Line**  
Once the main access for road trains travelling to Poeppe Corner, it is now a Public Access Route (PAR) through Clifton Hills Station.
